
Beloved people of God, next Wednesday, we will begin our Lenten campaign; that holy season in which we contemplate the passion and death of Christ for our redemption. It is so special that the beginning of Lent coincides with Valentine's Day this year. It is a special reminder that Christ suffered and died on the Cross for the love of us all. He invites us to love one another as we have been loved.

In this special season the word of God resounds through the Prophet Ezekiel: "As I live, says the Lord, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked man, rather let him turn from his evil ways and live." (Ezekiel 33:11) Lent calls us first and foremost to repentance, to metanoia. It begins with getting back to a state of tranquility which leads to introspection and acknowledgement of our faults. It is a time of reconciliation with God and one another.

Lent allows Christ's faithful to wait for the sacred paschal feasts with the joy of minds made pure. This purity of heart is attained through prayer, fasting, self-denial/abstinence, almsgiving, and constant participation in the mysteries by which the faithful are reborn and are led to the fullness of grace.

I therefore encourage our parishioners to frequent the sacrament of reconciliation, and to pray like never before. I strongly recommend regular attendance and active participation at Mass, Stations of the Cross, and all the Holy Week ceremonies. Make up your mind on what to give up for Lent as a way of raising little resources for charity, that way we bring the mercy of God, joy, peace, and comfort to others. May Mary, our mother, accompany us on this sacred pilgrimage of sanctity with her maternal intersession.
