THE IDAHO CATHOLIC APPEAL ORIGIN AND PURPOSE

What is today known as the Idaho Catholic Appeal (ICA), was the brainchild of The Most Reverend Sylvester William Treinen, Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Boise, 1962 -1989. In 1963, he came up with the Diocesan Development Project (DDP) appeal initiative, with the aim of raising funds for Diocesan projects, especially campus centers. This became the Parish Pledge Drive which included raising funds for the individual parishes. The idea behind the fund drive was that 1% of the income would go to the Diocese, 5% to the Parish, and the other 4% to other charities. A week before the beginning of Lent, Parish offices sent out a mailing. Appeal Sunday was usually set for the third Sunday of Lent.

In 1990, the Diocese of Boise's new Bishop, Most Rev. Tod David Brown (1989-1998) the emphasis of the appeal was on Diocesan programs, especially the training of seminarians. The seminaries were to receive 1/3 of the total DDP collection.

The Most Rev. Michael Patrick Driscoll became the new Bishop of the Diocese of Boise on January 18, 1999. Bishop Mike made significant changes to the Diocesan DDP Program. For one, the Idaho Catholic Charities, at 10%, were added to the beneficiaries of the DDP. Under Bishop Mike, the DDP changed to become the Idaho Catholic Appeal (ICA), which returned to the standard set by Bishop Treinen.

Worthy of mention is that there was the introduction of the following options:

1. Single gift

2. Pledge payment could be spread over ten (10) months. Here one could pledge \$1000 and spread it over 10 months as opposed to the initial single gift system.

3. Payment of pledges could be made through credit card, Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT), stock gift, and gift cards. Any of these are considered to have same value as cash and can be used. Parishioners who have stock can donate some of it, rather than money, to the Church. The Idaho Catholic Appeal is worth supporting because the wealth of the Church lies in the generosity of her faithful.

It is important to note that with the ICA, if a family makes a pledge and cannot redeem the pledge, the Diocese will not compel the family to pay as the law provides. 1st Sunday of Lent February 18, 2024
