
Secondly, I inherited some maintenance needs, which the Parish Council in conjunction with the Finance Council, the maintenance committee, and I have been closely looking at to figure out how best to start. These include, but are not limited to the church roof, the external walls of the Church building, the family center, the landscape, and the rectory. These we will take one at a time.

Coming into our church one sees a wonderful edifice that has stood the test of time—a church built with class, paying attention to details of Catholic architectural design, a masterpiece as far as church design is concerned. However, without any prejudice to my predecessors, I would like to observe that Jesus is at the center of our life and worship. This fact was taken into consideration in the original design of our Church with the Tabernacle at the very center that it may be the center of focus and attraction. We have agreed that it is time to return the Tabernacle to its proper place.

To do this, because the Tabernacle is not a piece of furniture that could be moved around at will, we are taking time to look at the details of what needs to be done. We have plans before Easter to let everyone in the community know what we plan to do in an open parish meeting.

Thirdly, St Mary's Parish School: several efforts are being made to maintain and improve different aspects of the life of the school, especially in making sure that it does not lose its Catholic character. The strategic planning committee is working hard to develop plans for sustainability and growth for the school.
