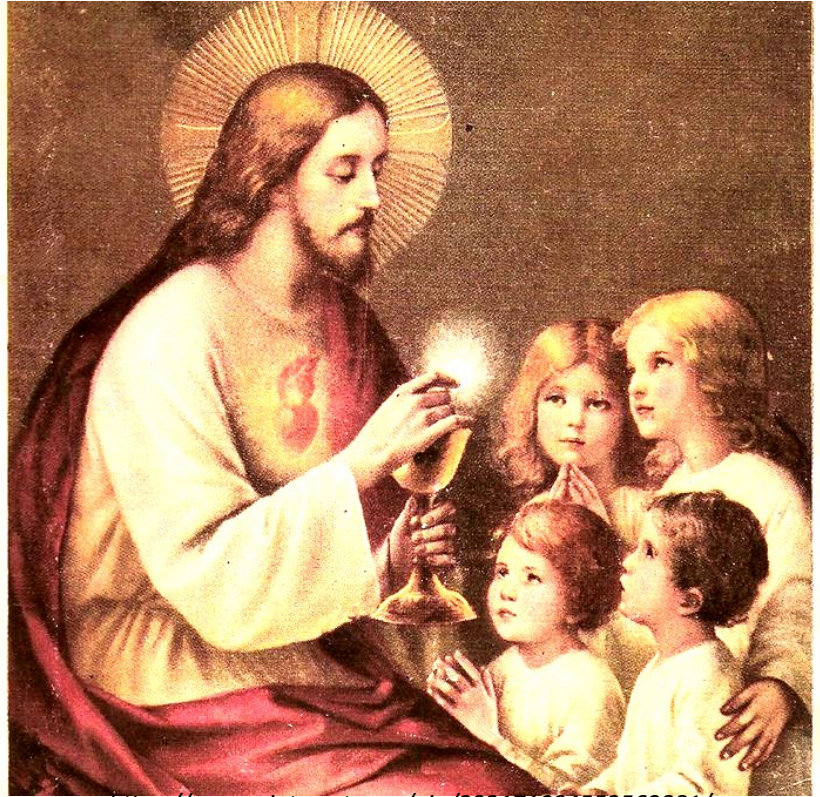
“Take it; this is my Body. Then He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, ... This is my Blood of the Covenant.” Mk 14:22

This Sunday, the Holy Mother Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). This has always been a special celebration in the Church, but more so this year, as the Catholic Church in the USA is celebrating a national Eucharistic Revival after 83 years. The last time was in St Paul Minnesota in 1941. The essence is to retell the love story between God and man. In love he created us; in justice we were condemned; and in mercy he redeemed us, as we find in the preface to the Eucharistic prayer. Jesus, who is fully present in His Divinity in the Most Holy Eucharist, made a visitation to our own State of Idaho between May 27 and 31. Congratulations to all who took advantage to catch a glimpse of Him in the Eucharistic procession this past week.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, we are reminded that there is no priesthood, no Church, no Christian spirituality, and no one who can love and serve the Lord in the Church without the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the source, the center, and the summit of Christian life. For there is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Jesus Christ Himself. *Lumen Gentium* No, 11, CCC 1324.

Let's cast back our mind to the first temptation of man, through Adam and Eve. The devil asked them to eat the forbidden fruit which was at the center of the garden. What they ate brought condemnation and death. By the bread of life will their life be restored. The first temptation of Jesus as well was, “If you are the Son of God turn these stones into bread.” Mt 4:13 What was the interest of the evil one on urging Jesus to turn stones into bread? As the principal angel, Lucifer was privy to the fact that God will send His Son into the world, and He will become the bread of life to restore fallen humanity to original innocence. He began to fight to detract from this life-giving bread.

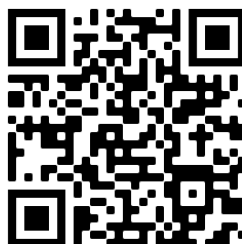

Note everything for which Jesus took flesh in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary, everything he lived for, everything he offered himself for on the altar of the cross and died, everything for which he rose from the dead is contained, offered, celebrated and received in the Most Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is our Sacrifice, our Real Food, our Communion and His Real Presence.

In recent past we have been talking about the location of the Tabernacle in our church and it seemed to have generated ill feelings, unease and discomfort. Know that that was never intended. Christ the Prince of Peace and the King of Love could never have wanted that from his people. Neither do I as a Pastor assigned to work among the people of God have any intention of creating any form of tension. As such I sincerely thank everyone who has genuinely expressed their thought about the Tabernacle move. You all have my honor and respect. We and the Parish Council are prayerfully considering how best to respond to your concerns to ensure that we continue to function as one big happy family.

My appeal is that we all keep an open heart and mind. Pray over the idea and please carefully read through these documents of the Church again asking the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE ROMAN MISSAL (GIRM) NO 314 and 315, Catechism of the Catholic Church no. 1379, The 1983 Code of Canon Law - canon 938, prayerfully read pages 28-30 of Built of Living Stones (Guideline of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) paying particular attention to the footnotes. Then let us come together as a family to work in harmony with moving the Tabernacle to its most appropriate place. It will be an honor to the Lord in this year of Eucharistic revival. It is a plea not an imposition.
