4th Sunday of Lent March 10, 2024

Beloved people of God,

As we gradually approach Holy Week which begins on Palm Sunday, the weekend of March 23rd and 24th, leading to the Sacred Paschal Triduum, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, we are stepping into the busiest and most sacred week of the entire liturgical year. We should remind ourselves of the following:

Palm Sunday

On this day the Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. Accordingly, the memorial of this entrance of the Lord takes place in all Masses. To this effect, the ceremony will begin at the Family Center followed by processions at the 11:30am Mass in Moscow and at 9:45am in Genesee.


At 5pm and 8am the ceremony will begin at the vestibule with a solemn entrance. All who can, will assemble at the vestibule shortly before Mass for the opening ceremonies.

Holy Thursday

This marks the beginning of the Sacred Triduum in which the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mystery of our redemption, keeping, by means of special celebrations, the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen. After the solemnity of the Last Supper in which we celebrate the institution of the Most Holy the priestly Order Eucharist. commandment of the Lord concerning fraternal charity, it is strongly recommended that we all keep the Sacred Paschal Fast beginning on Good Friday and could be prolonged to Holy Saturday as a way of coming, with spirit uplifted, to the joys of the Lord's Resurrection.

The holy Thursday ceremonies conclude with the transfer of the Santissima to the altar of repose and the stripping of the altar. In keeping with the request of the Lord "...keep watch with me one hour." Mt 26:40 the faithful are invited to continue adoration before the Blessed Sacrament for a suitable length of time during the night. After midnight the adoration should take place without solemnity.

Good Friday

On this and the following day, by most ancient tradition, the Church does not celebrate the Sacraments at all, except for Penance and Anointing of the Sick. Good Friday liturgy will begin as scheduled; featuring the Stations; celebration of the Lord's Passion which consists of three parts, namely Liturgy of the Word, Adoration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. On this and the following day the altar is left bare, reminding us that everything was taken away from Jesus except the Father's love.

Holy Saturday

On this day the Church waits at the Lord's tomb in prayer and fasting, meditating on his Passion and death and on his descent into Hell, and awaiting his Resurrection. We gather after nightfall for the solemn Easter vigil.

Kindly plan to take active part in these grace filled ceremonies that lead us to Paschal joys, the abundance of which overflows to occupy fifty days.


