> Pentecost Sunday May 19, 2024

Come Holy Spirit fill the hearts of the faithful And kindle in them the fire of your love. Beloved friends in Christ, with the Solemnity of Pentecost we come to the end of Easter celebrations. On Monday we continue with the ordinary season of the year. But this conclusion of our yearly celebration of the Paschal Mysteries is only an end of a beginning and a beginning of an End. Our vocation is to carry on the great commission: "Go into all the world and proclaim the Good News to everyone." (Mark 16:15) "You will be my witnesses... to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:18). A quick flashback on the Paschal Mysteries shows that the death of Jesus was such an intolerable experience to his disciples, His Resurrection was incredible, and His glorious Ascension and the Coming of the Holy Spirit were transforming experiences. As we celebrate these mysteries, it seems to be a stretch of a single event. But it was not for the disciples who were in the middle of it all. We must put ourselves in their place in order to have a personal and fuller import of what they experienced.

Reflecting on the mystery we celebrate at Pentecost, the Holy Father Pope Benedict XVI said: "the sending of the Holy spirit is the culmination of the entire mission of Jesus, and Christ's entire mission is summed up in this: 'to baptize us in the Holy Spirit'." In other words, the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives is the assurance of salvation.

The Holy Spirit is the bond of love and the bond of unity as we can see from the readings of this Sunday. He is the animator of every soul, the Paraclete, the counsellor, our advocate and defender. Without the Holy Spirit we are like dry flour which cannot form a dough. Without Him we are like a dry land or withering plant that cannot bear any fruit. Let us open our hearts to the Spirit of God for He is the one who leads us to the fullness of the Truth.
