Giving of Ourselves--Eucharist Reflection

Daniel H. V. in the Diocese of St. Petersburg, Florida, shared this reflection after he participated in the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis this past July. Please consider its meaning for you!

"I am reminded of a question asked by St. Isaac Jogues, one of the North American Martyrs, just before his death. It's a question that I think all of us should ask ourselves in relation to the Eucharist: 'When shall I begin to give myself completely to him who has given himself to me without reserve?' As the Bride of Christ, we must now go out, be sent, and tell all nations about the reality of our Lord. We must be bold, be courageous, and be heroic. We must follow the example of the apostles and the saints, who gave up their lives for this reality and all it entails. The truth must be shared, because the Eucharist is too sweet a food to be kept to ourselves."


