Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross began as the practice of pious pilgrims to Jerusalem who would retrace the final journey of Jesus Christ to Calvary.

Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church.

St. Mary's Church invites you to join us in this devotion. Each Friday during Lent, we gather as a community for a simple, meatless Soup and Bread supper at 5:30pm in the Family Center and then go over to the Church for Stations of the Cross at 6:15pm.

For those who prefer to pray this devotion earlier in the day, we also offer a noontime Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 12:15pm.

Parishioners at St. Mary's in Genesee are invited to a similar Soup and Bread supper at the Parish House at 6:00pm on Fridays, followed by Stations of the Cross at 7:00pm in the Church.
